## WHAT IS THE GOAL FOR CAMP?

Our goal at camp is to:

- Impart spiritual, social and cultural values into the lives of young deaf children and teenagers.
- To provide Deaf adults as role models to encourage and help them reach their maximum potential.
- To build unity, solidarity, and self-confidence among Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing individuals.
- To develop long-lasting relationships to enhance the future of our young people.

The majority of our counselors are Deaf adults who have leadership roles in our churches. They are great role models to the campers. They play a major role in the success of the camp. We have a ratio of one counselor per four campers. Teams are divided up into groups with two counselors per dorm.

## HISTORY OF IMPACT DEAF YOUTH CAMP

The camp is open to any deaf or hard of hearing child 8 and above. This year will be our third year of Deaf Youth Camp. In 2009 Rev. Mason Fenner had a desire to start a youth camp for the deaf in Southeastern United States. He had a burden to make a great impact on the deaf youth. He started out at a small camp located in Dandridge, Tennessee from 2009-2010. Because of the increasing cost of camp, we took two years break. Finally God has answered our prayer, this year the camp was moved to Toccoa, Georgia.

We have been working hard to keep Deaf Youth Camp going. During the first year many young lives were influenced and changed through their experience at the summer camp.



## WHAT ARE SOME ACTIVITIES?

There are various activities such as crafts, sports, games, swimming, team-building, tubing, and many other activities.

## WHO CAN GO TO CAMP

This is a camp for Deaf, Hard-of-Hearing, and CODA children 8-18 years old. All counselors are fluent in ASL (most are deaf) and desire to be role models to our young people. It will be a great week of fun and excitement.
